



Welcome to Year 3/4

- Reading diaries will be sent home daily – please sign each time you hear your child read.




Home Learning

- Don't forget to check the website/ APP/ Facebook for other information and learning that is happening in school.





- **80% of those who regularly came to the after school club got over 20/25**
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





