

St. Paul's: Year 2 Curriculum Map - Autumn 2 Topic: We are one

Outcomes for the topic:

Florence Nightingale and her work will be explored in History, and how she cared for the community her, We will use her to inspire our writing.

As we prepare for Advent, we will come together as a year group to perform our Nativity to our community.

Mathematics

Year 1 will be learning to add and subtract within 10.

Year 2 will be describing and making patterns with 2D and 3D As well as finding lines of symmetry within 2D shapes. In statistics we will be making and interpreting pictograms, tally charts and block diagrams. (1s,2s,5s and 10s)

Science

We are all the same yet so different!

We will learn about the life cycle of different animals, humans and understand what animals need to keep them alive and healthy. We will look at a healthy diet and the effects of exercise.

Art and Design/ DT

We will be using our drawing skills to create a picture of Florence Nightingale by applying different tones. We will also create our own personal Christmas Card.

Computing Digital writing


This half term, we will combine Computing and Science through Digital Writing. This will include:

English



Year 1 will be consolidating letter formation, capital letters and full stops.

In Year 2, we will be learning about in verbs and subjects in our Grammarsaurus unit.

Year 2 will be writing a non-chronological report about Florence Nightingale. We will be reading stories such as Vlad and the Florence Nightingale adventure.

Music

In music we will use our voices to sing songs, chant and rhymes with growing confidence. We will use different instruments to create and follow simple rhythms. We will be practising, rehearsing and performing our Christmas Nativity.

PSHE

In PSHE we will learn what bullying is, how it makes us feel and how it should be dealt with. We will learn how to show respect to others.

History

Florence Nightingale is a true advocate of treating all as one. We will be looking in detail at the life of Florence Nightingale and how she was and why she is an important figure in our history.

Catholic Social Teaching (CST)

Call to family, participation and community through our community project in RE, the actions of Florence Nightingale in History and through saying no to bullying in PSHE.

Physical Education

We will focus on dynamic balance and agility: Jumping and landing in a variety of ways and creating seated static balances.

We will cover target/racket skills focusing on the correct use and playing a target game.

RE

We will spend 3 weeks on Catholic Social Teaching and we will decide as a class on a project that we can take part in to help our local community.

In Advent, we can respond to the example of the prophets especially John the Baptist by preparing a way for Jesus to be a full part of our lives.
