

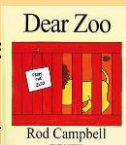
God's creation

During this half term children will be settling into a routine in St Annes classroom.



Literacy

This term we are reading books about animals including 'Oi Frog', 'Dear Zoo' and 'Shark in the Park'. We are learning to listen and interact in play based on a story. We are learning to sit for 2-3 minutes to complete a range of box tasks based



our play we have the opportunity to practice early writing by scribbling, drawing and tracing sounds.

Maths

Some of our box tasks are maths focused. We are working on concentrating and sitting for 2-3 minutes to engage in number activities such as tracing and showing a number with 1-1 help. In play we use a range of shapes and counting songs to motivate us to interact with numbers.

RE

In RE we are talking about doing everything with love according to our school's mission statement. We will show this by using kind hands and sharing with help from our adults. In play we will also explore the Creation Story where we will use water and animals to explore.

We will be learning to use real life photos to transition to different areas around the school. This will help us communicate our needs and wants. We also use Makaton signing to help our communication with peers and adults. We enjoy singing our good morning song each day.



We will also be observing seasonal changes as part of God's world around us. Brown crunchy leaves will be part of our sensory play to help us engage in the world around us.
