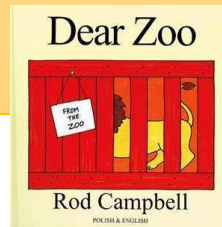
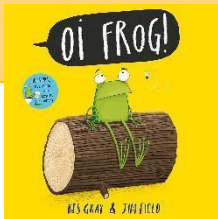
God's creation

During this half term children will learn about the creation story and be thankful for all God has given to us in the world around us



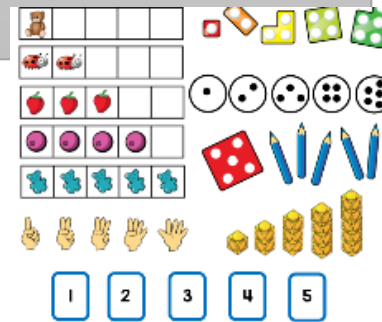
Literacy

This term we are reading books about animals including 'Oi Frog', 'Dear Zoo' and 'Shark in the Park'. We are learning to listen to stories with increasing attention and to handle books carefully. In Phonics we are going to learn the initial sounds using Read Write Inc. We will be focussing on blending simple CVC words such as mat, mad, sat.



Maths

In Maths we are working on Matching, Sorting and Counting numbers up to 3. "Can you count these apples? Can you line them up and touch them as you count? How many are there?" We will start exploring money, shapes and time.



RE

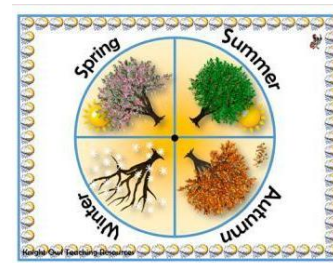
