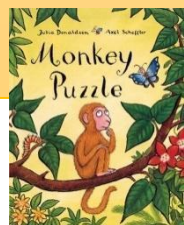

### We are One

This term we will be working as one to retell the nativity story to our school community, friends and family.



In **Literacy** this term we are reading lots of stories including 'Stick Man', 'Binny's Diwali' and 'Monkey Puzzle'. We are going to learn that print carries meaning and, in English, is read from left to right and top to bottom. We will be segmenting the sounds in simple words and blend them. By now we have finished learning Set 1 letter sounds and we are focusing on **WRITING** words and short sentences.



In **Maths**, the children will build on their subitising skills. They will continue to use instant recognition - by saying the number of sounds that they can hear, such as claps or drum beats, without needing to count. We will continue to explore shapes with 3 & 4 sides.

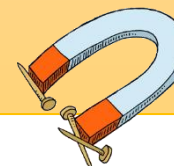


In **RE** we will listen to and talk about religious stories like Mary and Joseph's travels to Bethlehem and role play different teachings. During Advent we are going to learn about waiting and celebrating for the birth.

We look forward to sharing our nativity.



In **Knowledge and Understanding of the World** we are continuing observe seasonal changes. We will ask How? And Why? Questions and link information to solve problems. This is an exciting term as we are learning about the Hindu celebration of Diwali, Bonfire Night and Remembrance Day.



In our **PSED** learning we will be taking part in circle times where we will explore how to tell others our interests and feelings. We will also be showing **we are all one** through anti bullying day where we wear odd socks.
