

St. Paul's: Year 1/2 Curriculum Map – Autumn 1 Topic: God's Creation

Outcomes for the topic:

We will be reading information texts and stories about God's planet and God's creatures.
 We will gather information from informative videos outlining what plants need to survive.
 We will know where in the world we are and appreciate God's creation around us through technology and Art.



Mathematics

Year 1 will be looking at place value up to 10. They then will move onto looking at addition and subtraction within 10.

Year 2 will focus on the place value of numbers and strategies for addition and subtraction.

Science

We will learn about plants including how seeds and bulbs grow and what they need to survive.

We will also start our longitudinal study looking at minibeasts in different seasons.

Art and Design

We will be mixing and matching hues by identifying and mixing primary and secondary colours.

We will look at texture by printing and leaf rubbing.

Computing Digital Music

We will explore how music evokes emotions. We will create various sounds and musical patterns using computers.
 We will be exploring our own self image online and our relationships online.

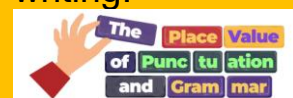
English
